Trevino Circle / Monterey Road Channel Improvements Project (Non - Mandatory)  
10:00 AM Thursday November 3, 2016

The project is drainage improvement to reinforce the channel to slow the flow of water. The work will consist of stabilizing the bottom of the channel, grading, putting down stacked stone walls and cross vanes, tree planting and landscaping.

The work should take 150 days. The project is a 50/50 revenue sharing with VDOT. Davis – Bacon does not apply and there is no Federal funding.

This project is the first stormwater channel improvements project which utilizes natural stream restoration techniques to improve storm water drainage throughout the City.

The Successful Bidder shall provide an experienced Superintendent per Pg. 83 Section 1.7 of the Special Conditions.

The recently installed storm drain outfall to existing Gabion baskets channel should not create a conveyance problem for this project.

The stone for the stone wall can be manufactured stone per Pg. 17 of the project drawings.

The City has acquired all the right of way necessary for the construction of the project.

The project was designed by Draper – Aden.

The requirement that the Bidder shall be an experienced channel and stream restoration contractor who shall list three (3) completed projects, no less than 1,000 linear feet for each project, completed within the last five years, is mandatory.
