1. Would the City provide a pricing page to be completed by all proposers?

***No. Offerors should propose their pricing based on their understanding of the City's needs as referenced in the RFP.***

2. Will the City allow/invite proposers to attend the Testing of carts described on page 12, #2?

***No.***

3. Please confirm that the requirement for industry standard warranty replacements as part for part replacements (for example: if a wheel fails, the wheel is to be replaced, if a body fails, the body is to be replaced, if a lid fails, the lid is to be replaced).

***Offerors should submit proposals based on their proposed solution to the City's need pursuant to Section 3 and 6.***

4. We respectfully request that injection molded lids be accepted for carts.

***Offerors should submit proposals based on their proposed solution to the City's need pursuant to Section 6.***

5. We respectfully request that the City also allow the correct resin for rotationally molded cart bodies, that of medium density polyethylene (MDPE). We respectfully request that the use of medium density polyethylene with density of 0.938 g/cm<sup>3</sup> and melt index (MI) at 3.3 to 3.5 grams/10 min be also allowed for carts.

***The City has set forth minimum requirements in the RFP. Offerors should submit proposals based on their proposed solution to the City's need pursuant to Section 6.***

6. Will the City accept the different material and thickness for lids from bodies?

***Offerors should submit proposals based on their proposed solution to the City's need pursuant to Section 6.***

7. Will the City unload carts and place where needed?
