**Franklin Road and Wonju Street Intersection Improvements**

**ROANOKE, VIRGINIA**

This project is generally described as construction of an upgraded traffic signal system using poles and mast arms (with video detection and spread spectrum radio interconnect) and will require removing concrete medians on two (2) approaches; construction of a new landscaped median and modification of an existing concrete median; construction of a concrete sidewalk and curb ramps (including earthwork and landscaping); eradicating existing pavement markings; construction of new pavement markings; repair of asphalt pavement and maintaining traffic during construction at and near the intersection of Wonju Street, Franklin Road and Broadway Avenue in the City of Roanoke and associated work.


