Cast In Place Drop Inlets

1) Will any other work be going on in the area simultaneously? If so to what extent do we provide traffic control measures in relation to measures already being handled under the larger project?

Yes. The City will be installing new pipe as part of this project. Traffic Control measures will already be in place; installed by the City of Roanoke Stormwater Division.

2) Given that the work is in a VDOT right of way do we need a land use permit from VDOT and a land use permit surety bond? If a land use permit is required will VDOT Traffic control certifications be required to obtain it?

This work is being done in the City of Roanoke Right of Way. A Right of Way Excavation Permit will be required. The Contractor shall apply for the permit but exempted from associated permit fee.

3) Will the area be excavated (by others doing the larger project) prior to starting on the drop inlets or do we figure all related excavation in our bid?

Yes, The City of Roanoke Stormwater Division will have this area excavated

4) Is there any prebid meeting for this project? I did not see one referenced in the bid packet.

5) The bid packet has work outside the scope of this project. Am I interpreting correctly in assuming we are to only bid on the scope as specified in sections 03290 and 03300?

The Contractor shall perform construction activities for all bid items in accordance with Section 03100, 03290 and 03300 of the Technical Specifications, as applied.

6) Given possible coordination with other work do you have any projections on timelines for starting this project?

The City's portion is scheduled to start around Jan 4, 2016 pending weather related delays.

7) Does the work include sidewalk and entrances included in the plans?

No.

8) Is it allowed to cast in place the bases of the drop inlets and use a City standard top?
No. Cast in place with a removable lid/top will not be accepted.

9) Will it be deemed acceptable to use Precast Mono Box Inlets on this project. I can not find a VDOT standard for DI-3B, 3C that allows a height that short, cast in place or precast. If the City is using a standard for construction; can you send that out?
